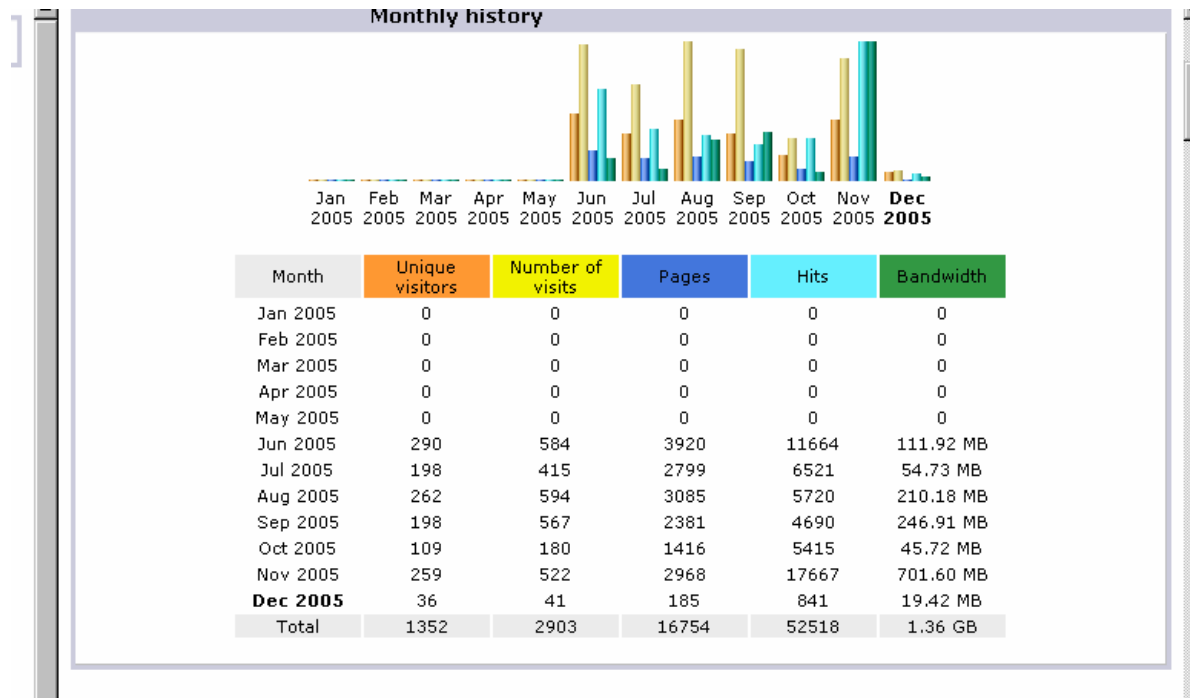

Radiant Hands, Inc. was initiated by a group of women who saw a need in the community to develop a network of help. Radiant Hands, Inc. identified deficiencies in the local community when it comes to disseminating information about available programs to help those in need and available funds as a stopgap measure to help families. A committee of volunteers was set up to research a list of government agencies, drug companies that offer low cost medication, and doctors who are available to donate time. The committee have helped direct applicants to government agencies to get low cost housing, directed women and families to medical services provided by the government at low or no cost and even found medical personnel within the community who are willing to help those in need. Radiant Hands, Inc. has provided money to pay the tuition costs of a mother, with an ailing child, so that she could receive further training to help her obtain employment to support herself and her child. The money came from donations, bake sale and yard sales. The organization has also helped pay utility bills thus preventing termination of service and collected and redistributed clothing items, in addition to collecting clothing items, food and personal hygiene items for the hurricane victims. Radiant Hands, Inc. also assisted another single parent with three children to locate low cost housing and move into

an apartment and out of temporary shelters provided by the local churches. Items used to furnish the house were collected from members of the community and then given to this family.

Radiant Hands, Inc. has held events for children in the community enabling the children to join together for fun activities in a safe environment away from the dangers of the streets.

In addition, Radiant Hands, Inc. paid the registration costs of 4 people to attend the South East Muslim Student Association conference recently held in Gainesville, FL. At this event, nationally known speakers were brought to the community to discuss Islam, and the event was open to the general public. Approximately 60% of the time is spent on fundraising activities.. In addition, volunteers in the organization have initiated a Youth Study Circle for Middle and High School Students that is held in a private home on Wednesday evenings. This activity is open to the general public should they wish to attend. The purpose of this activity is to encourage discussion of ideas, concepts and Islamic topics. Approximately 5% of the time is spent on organization.

The plan also includes scheduled fundraising events in order for educational scholarships to be offered to the community, and funds are available to ensure monetary help is accessible for those requiring short term financial assistance. Included in upcoming events will be “Kids Healthy Start” where members of the group have invited speakers from the Alachua County Health Department to give a presentation on services available to ensure children have access to health care. In addition, speakers from a local organization called “Peaceful Paths”, who counsel victims of spouse abuse, is being contacted to give a lecture on their services. These organizations do not charge for their talks and there will be no charge for the event, however people will be encouraged to continue to donate to Radiant Hands, Inc. at that time. Radiant Hands Inc. designed and purchased buttons for children to celebrate Eid Celebrations in the community.
